Before Saturday each week:

- If you are unable to umpire/Standby as per the roster you need to **organise your own substitute**.
- If there are any changes to the roster, please notify your coach/manager
- The coach/manager must provide any changes to Club Umpires' Convenor (Michelle Marks) at umpires@peninsulanetball.org & mimarks06@gmail.com before 5:00pm on the Wednesday before the game. This allows Michelle time to finalise the umpiring allocations and roster of mentors for Saturday.
- please do not email or phone Michelle if you are unable to umpire — it is your responsibility to organise your own substitute.

On Saturday — before the game:

- check in at the Peninsula Check-in Table (upstairs) **at least 20 minutes before the game is due to commence to get your name marked off**. Make sure you allow plenty of time for parking. If you do not check in on time, a 'umpiring penalty' will be issued. Not being able to find a parking spot will not be accepted as an excuse for failure to check in on time.
- know the court and the grade of the game you have been rostered to umpire.
- if you are rostered as a Standby, you need to check in at the Peninsula Check-in Table. You will be asked to sit upstairs until about the end of the first quarter, just in case you are needed.
- if you are rostered as a MWNA reserve, you need to check in at the Peninsula Check-in Table. Reserve umpires are to cover **injury and illness of umpires only for all clubs in the timeslot**. These reserve umpires will not be available to cover absent club umpires.
- be appropriately dressed and ready to umpire, which means in club playing uniform or dressed in white, with suitable netball footwear and a whistle and elastic. Note that you will now be required to wear a white shirt or white bib over your playing uniform to help differentiate between umpires and players. Club fleece tops (with white bib over) should only be worn if the weather is very cold — no coloured tops, track pants or leggings can be worn.
- be at your court ready to complete pre-game duties at least 10 minutes before the game is due to commence.

What happens if the umpire does not check in or is late?

The arrangements for 'umpiring penalties' imposed by MWNA are different to previous years:

- if the umpire allocated by the Club does not arrive at the court by the start of the game, the playing team has one minute to provide an umpire capable of managing the age and grade. If no suitable umpire can be provided within one minute of commencement of the game, then a forfeit can be claimed by the opposing team.
- the same umpire must control the entire game (except for injury or illness). A forfeit can be claimed by the opposing team if more than one umpire is used to control the game.

Peninsula has also imposed the following 'umpiring penalties' for umpires that do not check in on time or who are late:

- **player will not be permitted to play for their team for the following week, however, the player must still attend the game.**
- **fine of \$30, which must be paid (to the Club's nominated charity) before the player can play for their team again.**
